**Important Notes:**

- Only **female** candidates are eligible to apply.
- There is **no hostel** facility in the college.
- For eligibility criteria, number of seats and other details please visit our website.
- Admission to any course of the college is provisional, subject to final approval of the **University of Calcutta**.
- If a candidate wishes to apply for more than one Honours subject she will have to submit separate application for each subject.
- Applicants must get a print out of the application form after making the online submission for her personal record.
- Admission fees can be deposited **on-line as well as off-line** (through Bank Challan) modes.
- Application Fee for each subject is **Rs 60/-** payable at **any branch of State Bank of India(SBI Collect)** from **30<sup>th</sup> May, 2017 (Evening) to 13<sup>th</sup> June, 2017** (during Banking Hours for offline mode) and also through BillDesk payment gateway.
- Relaxation of the last date for online application and submission of fees is not permitted.
- By clause (g) of sub-section (1) of section 26 of the University Grant Commission Act, 1956, “UGC Registration on Curbing the Menace of Ragging in Higher Education Institute, 2009”, will be implemented.
- Admission to the college will be granted on the understanding that the student undertakes to conform to the rules and disciplines of the college in all respects.

## Courses offered, Combination of Subjects and Intake Capacity

1. A candidate taking up B.A./B .Sc. (Honours) and B.Sc. General Courses shall study:
  - i) Honours subjects with two General subjects combination (for B.A. /B .Sc. Honours) or three General subjects combination (for B.Sc. General Course).
  - ii) Language group: English (Compulsory) and Bengali or Alternative English.
  - iii) Environmental Studies.
2. 22% and 6% of the seats are reserved for Schedule Caste (SC) and Schedule Tribes (ST) whereas 10% and 7% of the seats are kept reserved for Other Backward Class- A (OBC-A) and Other Backward Class- B (OBC-B) respectively.
3. SC, ST, OBC-A and OBC-B candidates from West Bengal are only eligible for reserved seats.
4. As per G.O.No 65-Edn(U)/1U-89/13 Date: 16.10.2014, person with disabilities will enjoy 3% reservation in each of the categories, i.e. SC, ST, OBC-A, OBC-B and the General category.

## Eligibility Criteria for the Admission

**1.** A candidate who has passed the Higher Secondary (10+2) or its equivalent examination is eligible to seek admission to the 1st year of the 3-year B.A. /B .Sc. (Honours) and B.Sc. General Courses of Studies provided she has also passed in **English having full marks not being less than 100.**

**2.** No candidate shall be allowed for admission after a lapse of more than 5 years from the year of passing the previous qualifying examination or discontinuation of recognized regular Course of Study after passing the previous qualifying examination.

**Explanation:** The year of admission shall not be taken into account while calculating 5 years from the year of passing the previous qualifying Examination.

**3.** A candidate shall be allowed to take up the subject (s) under heading **A** if she had passed the subject(s) under heading **B** at the previous qualifying examination.

**1. Microbiology , Botany and Zoology or Physiology : Passed in Biology and Physics/Chemistry**

**2. Microbiology, Food and nutrition and Zoology or Physiology: Passed in Biology and Chemistry**

**Some Special condition for admission to Honours Courses as Follows:**

**Economics:** A candidate shall be allowed to up Honours in Economics if she has passed in Mathematics at the H.S. Examination (10+2) conducted by the West Bengal Council of H.S. Education or its equivalent examination in Mathematics/ Business Mathematics. Students who have passed Business Economics including Business Mathematics in H.S. (10+2) level from West Bengal Council of H.S. Education are also eligible for admission in the Honours Course in Economics.

**Mathematics:** A candidate shall be allowed to take up Honours in Mathematics if she has passed in Mathematics at the previous qualifying examination. A candidate who has passed in Business Mathematics is not eligible for admission to the Mathematics Honours Course.

**Physiology:** A candidate shall be allowed to take-up Honours in Physiology if she passed the subject Physiology/ Biology/Bio-Technology and Chemistry in the previous qualifying examination.

**4. Aggregate means total marks of the best four subjects (at least 100 marks paper). However, marks in compulsory Environmental Education /Studies shall not be taken into account for calculation of aggregate marks.** If the subject "Environmental Science" is studied as an elective subject of 100 marks, may be taken into account for the purpose determining the aggregate marks.

5. Admission will be conducted on the basis of provisional merit list. Provisional Merit list will be generated on the basis of **Index Mark** (formula given on the list below).

6. For admission a SC/ST candidate must secure not less than 25% and an OBC candidate must secure not less than 10% of index mark of the last admitted candidate in General Category in Honours and General Courses.

**A Candidate taking up Honours/General Courses in a subject must have obtained the minimum eligibility marks as follows:**
